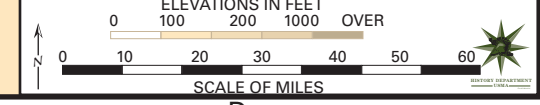


KENTUCKY - TENNESSEE, 1861
HENRY and DONELSON CAMPAIGN
 Strategic Situation at the End of the Campaign, 27 February 1862



Beauregard personally arrived at Jackson on 16 Feb. and assumed command of all troops between the Mississippi and Tennessee Rivers.

Concentration completed early in March.

Reinforcements: Bragg (10,000) from Mobile and Ruggles (5,000) from Louisiana enroute.
