WEST POINT TO HOST 36TH ANNUAL MILITARY TATTOO – April 11, 2018

WEST POINT, N.Y. – The U.S. Military Academy will host its 36th annual Military Tattoo at 11 a.m. on Sunday, April 22, at the Trophy Point Amphitheater.

This tattoo brings together numerous performance groups, both civilian and military, to pay homage to the rich military traditions of Pipes and Drums. The event will feature the U.S. Corps of Cadets Pipes and Drums, Drill Team and Celtic Dancers; the Hellcats; and more than 20 bands and dance groups from the Hudson Valley. The tattoo will conclude with a “mass bands” event at 6 p.m.

The event is free and open to the public. All visitors should enter the installation via Thayer Gate, located in Highland Falls, New York. Proper identification will be required upon entering academy grounds, and all vehicles are subject to search.

In the event of inclement weather, the event will be rescheduled for Sunday, April 29.
