

CORNWALLIS
(1,900)

Note: Cornwallis made a frontal attack immediately after a twelve-mile march, bringing his rear units forward into line as his front widened and holding out only his cavalry as a reserve. Despite severe losses, the British pressed their assault until Greene decided to withdraw.

N.C. Militia flanked by picked light troops. Militia fired two volley and withdrew as at Cowpens but could not be rallied.

VA. Militia fought well, especially left - flank units.

Fought well except for left flank regiment and retired in good order.
