SUBJECT: Authorization of United States Military Academy (USMA) to Participate in
the Army Domestic Technology Transfer Program (ADTTP)

In accordance with Army Regulation (AR) 70-57, the USMA is authorized to participate in the ADTTP. Furthermore, in accordance with AR 70-57, the Superintendent, USMA may: (1) enter into Cooperative Research and Development Agreements and (2) license, assign, or waive rights to intellectual property created by the USMA. This authority may not be delegated.

In fulfilling the responsibilities of a specified laboratory or center, USMA shall comply with all applicable statutes (e.g., Title 15 United States Code (U.S.C.) Section 3710a et seq. and Title 35 U.S.C. Section 209) and regulations.
