

Chapels at West Point

Criteria for getting married at West Point:

- Either the bride or the groom is an Academy graduate
- Either the bride or the groom is active duty stationed at West Point, or dependents of active duty personnel stationed at West Point

NOTE:

- Weddings are not held at West Point on Saturdays with home football games
- Most chapels at West Point are not equipped with air conditioning
- Chapels do not charge a user fee; however, donations are appreciated and at the user's discretion
